PHOTO ID: A Federal or Tennessee State Government issued photo ID is **required to vote**, unless an exception applies. Voters who vote absentee by mail, residents of licensed nursing homes, assisted living centers, or those hospitalized are exempt.

TCA 2-7-111: Display and distribution of campaign posters, signs or other campaign materials, and solicitation of votes is strictly prohibited within 100 feet of any polling place entrance.
